BO-VALLEI CHENIN BLANC 2015

The Bo-Vallei, which is located on the outskirts of Wellington towards Bain's kloof, has been our home for more than two centuries and our legacy of vines and wine is woven into the fabric of its history.

This beautiful, small and undiscovered valley is surrounded by the Hawekwa mountains, Limiet mountains and the Groenberg and located some 70km from Cape Town. With a backdrop of beautiful landscapes, it has a magical atmosphere that will captivate you once you discover it.

Originally our home town Wellington was known as Limiet Vallei (border or frontier valley). The area became known as Wagenmakersvallei (Valley of the Wagon Makers) towards the end of the 17th century when the French Huguenots settled here.

Our farms situated in this valley are extremely well suited for the cultivation of Chenin Blanc. Sunny days, well drained soils and slopes which forms a myriad of micro pockets all lends itself to making wines with an abundance of fruit and appeal.
