"I tasted these two wines quite quickly, but liked them straight away, which is always a positive sign. Squishy cherry, mint, rosy perfume, a little spice and rhubarb. Poached strawberry and cherry, juicy but kind of autumnal and mushroom on forest floor stuff – well, you know what I'm getting at, maybe. Tannin is light, fine and powdery. Finish long and savoury. Also, the flavour is not diffuse due to any alcohol warmth, which is lovey to see."
