Ageing/Finishing

12 months in French Oak Barrels. Blended and bottled in June 2014.

Complex aromas of dark stone fruits, smoke and toasty oak.

Full bodied, dense, velvety palate with great structure and a long, persistent finish.

Howard's Folly is a small producer of wine from the Alentejo region of Portugal.

The winemaker, David Baverstock, is an Australian by nationality but long time Portuguese resident who is credited with revolutionizing the Portuguese wine industry by introducing new

world techniques to old world material. He has won the Portuguese Red Wine Trophy at both the 1999 and 2002 International Wine Challenges, as well as winemaker of the year (Portugal) 1999, the first non Portuguese Winemaker to do so. He is the head winemaker for the world famous Herdade do Esporão.
