Wine has been flowing in the Clare Valley since 1851 and is an integral part of the culture. It is one of Australia's most prestigious premium wine regions, most famous for its Riesling and Shiraz. A small area, accounting for less than 1.5% of Australia's total wine production.

With its beautiful, rolling hills, ideal winter rainfall and Mediterranean climate, the Clare Valley carries a unique history and winemaking heritage.

Winemaking Notes

This wine is a deep red colour with a ruby hue.

Intense dark fruit aromatics of blackberry and blackcurrant are complimented with richer notes of dark mint chocolate and roasting herbs.

The palate is vibrant, with blackberry flavours and a layering of sage and rosemary.

Firm, fine tannin frames a long, persistent finish of bright berry fruits and a touch of savoury oak toast.

This wine is immensely drinkable now but will improve with cellaring.
