Deep, bright purple/red colour with a peppery, red cherry, smoky, fireplace-ash character, also root vegetables; Very light colour and a fresh, intensely fragrant aroma, very impressive and appealing. The wine is steely on the palate, dry and tart and high acid, with a lean profile and great delicacy and refinement. Intense lime and lemon flavours. An excellent young riesling, but it's very tight and restrained, and demands patience. (This won't be released for at least another year).
