Winemaker's Comments

Back by popular demand is the Grower's Blend Sauvignon Blanc made from grapes selected from neighbouring vineyards. This is a very expressive wine that gives off notes of papaya, pineapple, wet stone and hints of gooseberry that one expects from Sauvignon Blanc. Mouth-watering acidity is noticed first but is perfectly balanced by fruit flavours of tart pineapple, Meyer lemon and tropical fruits. The finish is crisp, clean and satisfying.

Food Pairings

Sauvignon Blanc with its higher acidity and aromatic qualities is a dream to pair with food. Try this delicious wine with a goat cheese tart, asparagus quiche or a tuna sushi roll. Also keep in mind that a wine as beautifully balanced as this one does not need food to be enjoyed properly.
